Hi Kate

I hope your well.

Attached is the spreadsheet with both Weston and East stocking programs for each option of poultry. I have colour coded each stocking option and used the standard emissions values for each one.

The Turkey manager states that after brooding for 42 days the turkeys are on the range for 70 days. I have attached the East Farm emission factor from the previous app.

The species will be mixed, the two most likely are Devon Bronze and super mini specials, the attached has the weights for mixed species, they have over 300 to choose from.

Weston Farm will only have sheds 1-2 rebuilt at this time as per the attached and submitted data, sheds 3-4 will stay the same.

East Farm ventilation will be comprised of 8 chimney fans for each shed at the stated speed, internal drainage to underground tank as per drawing.

I will give you a call tomorrow to explain.

Hi George,

Thanks for letting me know. We will need the final plans, for both birds and houses, for both Weston and East by Tuesday or I will have no option but to return the applications unfortunately.

I have sent you a couple of other bits of info we will need clarifying for Weston by then as well thank you.

For East Farm, can you address the points below please. The permit states:

## Crop 1

- 100,000 turkeys (50,000 Stags/50,000 Hens).
- After 42 days 50,000 of the turkeys (25,000 Stags/25,000 Hens) are taken to other farms for rearing.
- The other 50,000 turkeys (25,000 Stags/25,000 Hens) remain on site and are transferred to roaming fields until they are 115 days old. After this time the birds are depopulated for the next crop.

Please confirm whether these will be Devon Bronze turkeys, the age of these turkeys at cycle commencement and whether until day 42 all the turkeys remain in houses with no access to the roaming area. After 42 days please confirm whether the turkeys are 100% of the time out on the roaming area. Please also confirm days empty between cycles.

## Crop 2 and 3

- Each with 20,000 Turkey Stags.
- Turkeys reared for 126 days, before depopulated for the next crop.

Please confirm whether these will be Devon Bronze turkeys, the age of these turkeys at cycle commencement and whether all these turkeys are free range, and if so, how many days they will remain inside for the initial indoor brooding period, and then following this, the % of time they will be inside the houses and the % time they will be on the ranging area. Please also confirm days empty between cycles.
