Our Impacts

- Water and Waste Water resulting in the use of energy and chemicals and drawing upon a resource increasingly under stress
- Solid Wastes resulting in disposal problems and the depletion of natural resources
- Packaging resulting in disposal problems and the depletion of natural resources
- Transport resulting in energy use, noise, congestion and, from aviation, other atmospheric pollution
- Chemicals with potential for pollution to air, water and land
- Agriculture and Fishing giving rise to pressure on eco-systems (land use, biodiversity and endangered species) and climate change impacts

Our Approach

The Group concentrates on the four main areas of environmental impact over which we have immediate operational control: **Energy, Water, Waste and Packaging.**

In addition, the Group has appointed a Responsible Sourcing Manager to work with our customers and suppliers, to identify and mitigate risks in our supply chains.
