I'm writing to let you know that your application is duly made as of 19/12/23. 'Duly made' means that we have all the information we need to start determination. Determination is where we assess and make a decision on your application.

During periods of high workload we may not be able to start determination straight away.

We want to give you a decision as quickly as possible. Once the officer has familiarised themselves with your application, they'll be able to give an estimate of timescales.

The determination time will depend on a number of factors, such as:
