Thank you for your application received on 31/03/2025.

I have now completed an initial review of your application for duly making purposes. As part of this I have carried out a revised ammonia screening assessment based on the lower number of broilers you are now applying for (208,300 birds) and this has concluded that ammonia modelling is no longer required so we will not be reviewing the modelling you submitted with the application. As a result we will refund the £620 you paid for the assessment of the modelling.

We require the following additional information and payment before we can duly make the application:

- 1. Please amend Table 1, question 7 of application form Part B3.5, to reference poultry houses 1 to 15 (currently refers to poultry houses 1 to 12).
- 2. Please amend question 14 of application form Part B3.5 and the 'Directors details' document to remove reference to Mr Thomas Wareham, as according to Companies House he is no longer a director for the company.
- 3. As there are European sites within the relevant screening distances, in accordance with Table 1.19 of <a href="The Environment Agency">The Environment Agency</a> (Environmental Permitting and Abstraction Licensing) (England) Charging Scheme 2022: version 1.4, a charge of £779 is payable for a Habitats Assessment (1.19.2). As we need to refund the £620 you paid for assessment of the ammonia modelling you will only need to pay the difference of £159.

- 4. Please submit a site boundary plan, in accordance with question 5a of application form Part B3.5.
- 5. Please add a north arrow and dirty water drainage routes from the poultry houses to the dirty water tanks, to the site drainage plan.
- 6. According to our mapping system, the site lies within flood risk zones 2 and 3. Please update the site condition report and accident risk assessment to reflect this.
