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Hello Anabella

I have had a look at the email chain and based on the type of activity proposed the level of qualification they are proposing to apply for would be sufficient.

As it's a new application we would require evidence they have registered on the course and also as it's a high risk activity they would then need to ensure they do the first four modules within 4 weeks of the commencement of operation and have 12 months to complete the remaining qualification or they can supply an EPOC as well and this would cover them for the first four modules.

I have noticed that Benjamin Wicken has supplied his EPOC if he is the same individual that is going to take the course referenced then we would just need to see evidence of registration and he would have 12 months from the date of operations to complete this course.
