



Environmental Policy

Viridis 178 develops and operates flexible power plants across the UK, helping to stabilise the National Grid by responding very rapidly to changes in the balance of electricity demand and supply, which enables the functioning of wind and solar power.

Viridis 178 is committed to minimising the environmental impact of its operations through the adoption of sustainable practices and continual improvement in environmental performance. We recognise the importance of good environmental performance in our business operation and will provide the necessary organisation, commitment and training to fulfil this obligation.

To do this, the organisation will:

1. Be aware of the environmental impacts of our operations and take steps to prevent pollution and minimise environmental harm and nuisance, through:

- Using energy efficiently to reduce use of fossil fuels and the production of associated greenhouse gas emissions;
- Minimise waste generation through promotion of re-use and recycling;
- Managing our sites to reduce potential noise impacts upon our neighbours;
- Be open to communication with the general public, including immediate neighbours, ensuring any potential problems and issues can be highlighted and resolved.

2. Monitor and comply with legislation, regulations, and other requirements on environmental matters relevant to our operations, through:

- Maintaining compliance with our environmental permit requirements;
- In our rapidly evolving sector, engaging with Government and regulators on how our important grid balancing role can be fulfilled with minimum environmental impact

3. Monitor, review, and continually improve our environmental performance, through:

- Monitoring, measuring and reviewing our environmental performance;
- Setting, monitoring and reviewing environmental objectives
- Incorporating environmental responsibilities into routine business operations
- Committing to effective communication systems on environmental matters through training and improved awareness.

This policy will be reviewed on an annual basis and updated as required.
