Claire

Please accept my apologies for the delay in responding.

We would recommend that the overlapping area is surrendered now to avoid any issues when eventually both permits are surrendered as there will be clear boundaries for each permit.

However the other option would be to undertake enough work now to characterise the area of land which is subject to the power plant and is covered by the chemical plant. You would then need to update the site condition records for the chemical plant and use this information to provide a baseline site condition report with the new permit application for the power plant. If the condition of the land is fully characterised this would avoid the need to part surrender some of the chemical plant permit.

With regard to the existing chemical plant permit - ICL will still need to vary this to include a new plan to show the whole installation boundary (i.e. the additional part where the power plant is) and where the existing boundary is. (this would need to include the overlapping area of land.

The two applications should be submitted at the same time.

I hope this sets out the options available but am happy to discuss this further.
