

HOPE CEMENT WORKS SO₂ ELV COMPLIANCE AND SHALE REPLACEMENT PROJECT UPDATE

Introduction

As agreed with the Environment Agency, this document will provide a progress report for the shale replacement project at Hope Cement Works as well as a summary of compliance with the current reduced sulphur dioxide (SO₂) 400 mg/Nm³ emission limit value (ELV) for the Q4 reporting period (1st October 2019 – 31st December 2019).

SO₂ ELV Compliance Summary

Please see the below tabular summary of compliance with the current SO₂ 400 mg/Nm³ ELV for Kiln 1 and Kiln 2, and against the 695 mg/Nm³ ELV proposed in the outstanding derogation. Shale Replacement Project Update

Environmental impact assessment work has been continuing since the last update with no issues identified. Extensive ground contamination surveys have taken place in areas of potential excavation alongside demolition and asbestos surveys. Timescales are currently projecting that the planning application submission will be made early in Q2 2020.

The F10 notification to the HSE has been submitted for the project with Principal Designers (WSP CEL Ltd) instructed and the basic engineering design of the plant is progressing well, flowsheets are in draft and the constructability review has now taken place.



The project thus far has not deviated from the timelines agreed within the derogation submission.


Hope Cement Works continues to seek out a wide spectrum of substitute raw materials from locations with suitable quality material, site access and capacity for bulk transport and many site visits have been completed. This assessment is nearing completion, all options have been evaluated both technically and economically to select the most preferable source or sources of such materials. Commercial negotiations regarding the preferred material sources are being conducted and are on-going as appropriate. They are commercially sensitive and some subject to non-disclosure agreements.

In addition to the above, Hope Cement Works continues to receive up to 12 loads of conditioned quality PFA per day by road as part of a trial agreement with the Peak District National Park. Contractually Hope Cement Works retains the right to utilise all run of station PFA generated at one particular power station as and when it becomes available and, more recently, has signed a second contract for further supplies of ash from a second power station. This has helped enable some higher raw mix substitution rates towards the end of the year. The table below reflects the monthly rates of shale substitution in the raw mix by weight for the whole of 2019.


