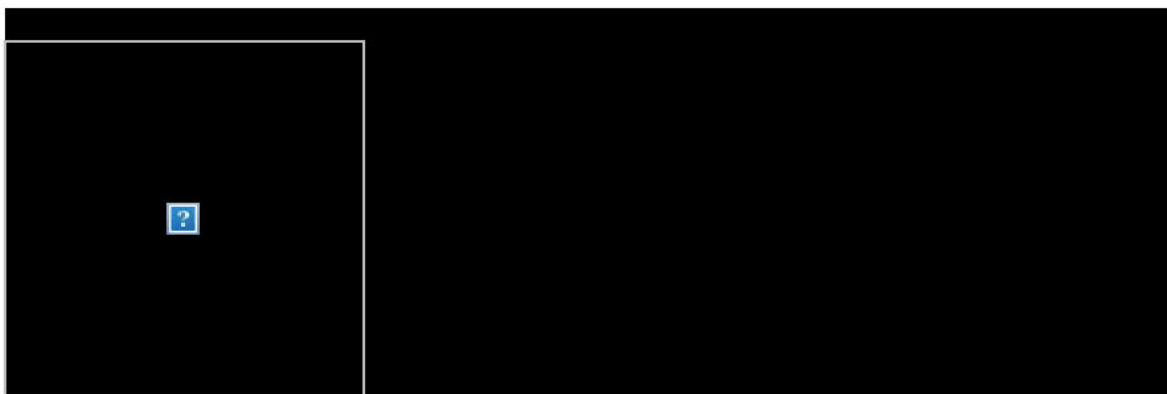

I'm writing to let you know that your application is duly made as of 07/12/23. 'Duly made' means that we have all the information we need to start determination. Determination is where we assess and make a decision on your application.

During periods of high workload we may not be able to start determination straight away.

We want to give you a decision as quickly as possible. Once the officer has familiarised themselves with your application, they'll be able to give an estimate of timescales.

The determination time will depend on a number of factors, such as:

- the complexity of the application
- whether we need to consult. See [Environmental permits: when and how we consult](#) for a list of applications that require public consultation.
- whether we need to ask you for further information so we can complete

determination.

From our initial checks, it's likely that we'll need to ask you for further information about technically competent management, e.g. evidence that the proposed TCM has passed TMNH at the continuing competence test that he is registered on. We'll contact you about this and any other items during determination. We'll explain what we need and how long you have to provide it.
