Dear Joanne,

Please accept the following information in response to your 'not duly made letter' dated 15th June.

1. The additional fees have been paid to cover the assessment of a Dust Management Plan and a Noise & Vibration Management Plan. The additional payment of £2,487 was made by BACS on 25th June under reference 'PSCAPPTHEOU123'. We have also updated form F1 to reflect these changes.
2. A Noise & Vibration Management Plan has been provided, report reference 17832/6.
3. Form B4 has been updated and the information in Table 1A now ties in with question 8 in Appendix 4.
4. The existing Nunnery Triangle Local Wildlife Site covers the whole of the site and planning permission allows for this to be redeveloped, which is the reason it hadn't been included on the initial submission. An area to the south of the site will be retained and a new Ecological-Geological Enhancement Area will be established and this area is now shown on the Site Layout (Drawing 17832/02A) and Receptor (Drawing 17832/3A) plans. The Environmental Risk Assessment (report ref 17832/3A) and ESSD (report ref 17832/4A) have also been updated.
5. The EMS has also been updated with the new drawing references.

We need more information about your application/Underpayment of application charge

Thank you for your application received on 30 April 2018. The following is to confirm our conversation of 15 June 2016

Unfortunately the application payment you sent is incorrect. The correct application charge is £11, 694. This leaves a balance of £2,487 to pay.

The breakdown of the additional fee is as follows.

You included the equivalent of a Dust Management Plan in Appendix A Air Quality Assessment in the Environmental Risk Assessment. The charge for our assessment of your plan is not included in your baseline application charge. You will therefore need to make an additional payment of £1,241.

You need to send us an Noise and Vibration Management Plan. This should meet the requirements of our Horizontal Guidance for Noise Part 2 – Noise Assessment and Control (<https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/environmental-permitting-h3-part-2-noise-assessment-and-control>). The charge for our assessment of your plan is not included in your baseline application charge. You will therefore need to make an additional payment of £1,246.

I also need to ask you for some more information before I can do any more work on your application. Please provide us with the following details.

You put R10 in Part B4 Table 1a but ticked No in response to 8c in Appendix 4 of Part B4. Please clarify whether or not you are applying for R10.

Nunnery Triangle Local Wildlife Site is not included as a receptor in the Environmental Risk Assessment. Please amend the Environmental Risk Assessment to include it.
