We still cannot duly-make the application as

- 1) The Noise Management Plan included in your EMS lacks detail and needs to be revised

Please see attached document which includes guidance on noise management and noise management plans

(e.g. what are the receptors, what is the distance between the noise sources and the receptors, what are your monitoring procedures, complaint procedures, working hours, abatement measures to be taken if noise is excessive – this is not an exhaustive list but they need to be included in your noise management plan.)
