Sludge doesn't come into the site for direct transfer off the site again – i.e. no material enters the site, is transferred to the tanks and then transferred back off site from the tanks.

However, cake (sludge which has been treated on another site and then dewatered) is brought to the site on occasion and stored in a similar manner to the cake produced on site, prior to removal from site.

The point about the H1 model is noted, I will try and evaluate what data we have for the model at this point.
