We are currently following a different process to notify you that your application is missing information. This means that you will not receive any additional notice from the Permitting Support Centre and this e-mail is your formal notification. As per our conversation today I need to ask you for some missing information before I can do any more work on your application. Kindly submit the following;

- Revise and resubmit your Non-technical summary to include a description of the facility type for SRP 2015 No6.
- Kindly submit a full list of the EWC you wish to take.
- Confirm that your treatment operations consist of only of manual sorting, separation, screening, baling, shredding, crushing or compaction of waste into different components for disposal, (no more than 50 tonnes per day) or recovery and confirm that no more than a total of 50 tonnes of intact and shredded waste vehicle tyres (waste codes 16 01 03 and 19 12 04) shall be stored at the site.
- Revise and resubmit Application Form - Part C4 - Table 2 – please remove the aspects listed. This table is for point source emissions only. Here you have included fugitive emissions. This issue's will be addressed under your management plans
- Kindly submit a copy of your environmental risk assessment and your environmental management system, showing consideration for this variation application.

Please send the information within 10 working days of this letter, if we do not receive the information within 10 working days we will return your application.

If we do receive the requested information within 10 working days, we'll continue to check your application. We'll check to see if there's enough information for the application to be 'duly made'. Duly made means that we have all the information we need to begin determination. Determination is where we assess your application and decide if we can allow what you've asked for.

We'll let you know by letter whether your application can be duly made. If it can't be duly made, we'll return your application to you.

If we do have to return your application we'll send you a partial refund of your application payment. We'll retain 20% of the application charge to cover our costs in reviewing your application and requesting information. This maximum amount we'll retain is capped at £1,500.
