Further to my email yesterday.

Regarding the methane compliance limit for BH17D. We originally agreed a limit of 6.7%v/v based on the Tmax (background) value of 6.2% + 0.5% in accordance with the Industry Code of Practice (ICoP) for stable datasets.

However, you have subsequently indicated that further analysis of the dataset showed the data to be unstable. With unstable datasets the ICoP states that the Tmax value should be used for compliance purposes. This would give us a compliance limit of 6.2%v/v. Therefore to be fully compliant with the ICoP, the compliance limit should be set at 6.2%v/v.

So please can you incorporate the above to the revised gas management plan.

Can you also check the MEPP to ensure that all perimeter gas monitoring points are shown as these will be referred to in the Table S3.5 of the permit, and ensure that all references to these monitoring points are correct within the gas management plan.
