I hope this email finds you well. Thank you for your letter dated 7th October 2020 in connection with the Briefing 7: NNB Generation Company HPC Ltd, Hinkley Point C Power Station, Hinkley Point, near Bridgwater, Somerset, TA5 1UD.

My Name is Brendan Sellick, My family is the last of the centuries old tradition of Mud Horse fishing. My family has fished the Bristol Channel for the last five generations and my son continues to do so to keep the long tradition alive - an important part of English Heritage. If you wish to know more about Mudhorse Fishing and my self, please use your search engine - you will find lots of short films to explain our livelihood and the tradition.

My family and myself would like to take this opportunity to express our concerns over the changes and the impact it will have and has had on our livelihood and the tradition of the Mudhorse.

During the consultation process we have continually expressed our concerns with regards to the extraction of fish from the estuary and the depletion of fish stocks caused by the intake of millions of litres of water a day to cool the reactors and thousands of fish and breeding shrimp stock has depleted I believe, because of this. This has effected my livelihood over the decades. I do not believe that I have been listened to or supported in any way by any of the government agencies or EDF.

Isn't it sad that after five generations and more it looks like Mudhorse Fishing is no longer viable, which is the most sustainable and environmentally friendly way of fishing. I have fifteen grandchildren and sadly none of them can see a future working the tides and I am sure that the extraction of water and fish is the contributing factor. Please present this email to the appeal process.
