Dear sir or madam,

I want a chance to make representations at the public inquiry on permit EPR/HP3228XT/V004 on the measures that should be taken to minimise fish death.

The terms of the Inquiry should be sufficiently wide to even allow for the scrapping of the licence to be considered, if the developer cannot meet the Habitats Regulations.

The killing of European Protected Species (EPS), which is likely to happen when fish are sucked in with the abstracted water, is forbidden under the Conservation of Habitats and Species law, when there is a viable alternative to the proposal. In this case, there is a viable alternative - to build a cooling system on the Hinkley Point site, using air-cooling or evaporative cooling towers.
