I would like to register an interest in the public inquiry into the cooling system under construction at Hinkley Point C

I object strongly to the NNB Genco material change application to not use Acoustic Fish Deterrent at Hinkley Point C. The original application included significant constraints to protect the ecology of the local environment and permission by the Secretary of State for HPC to go ahead was based on the condition insisted upon by the Environment Agency that an Acoustic Fish Deterrent be installed to protect the marine ecology.

Without the deterrent huge volumes of fish will likely be killed, including juveniles, which will wipe out the species from Bristol Channel waters. In addition European Protected Species will be amongst the fill killed, constituting an offence under the conservation of Habitats & species legislation.

The Severn Estuary has international status as a Marine Protection Area. It is totally unacceptable that EDF should seek to change a binding agreement. I object absolutely.
