I want a chance to make representations at a fully public Inquiry on the above.

The terms of the Inquiry should be wide, to ensure the removal of the licence. Any feasible fish diversion measures could not meet the Habitats Regs.

Further grounds for removal include:

- the new international status of the area as a Marine Protection Area
- the nuclear contaminants that would be disturbed in construction
- the killing of European Protected Species (EPS) sucked in with the abstracted water


The killing of EPS is forbidden under the Conservation of Habitats & Species law, when there is an alternative. There is an alternative - to build a cooling system on the Hinkley Point site, using air-cooling or evaporative cooling towers.

I am just a very ordinary member of the public and don't have any marine biological expertise but an understanding of the fragility of fish stocks along the estuary which feeds four of the most iconic rivers in the UK:-

- The Usk which has SSSI along the length of the river
- The Wye which has same status as the Usk
- The Severn
- The Avon
