I wish to object most strongly to any removal of acoustic fish deterrence at Hinkley C. The matter of protecting all fish stocks in our seas is of major importance as species and species which rely on them, become impacted by climate change. The enormous quantities of sea water extracted particularly for large scale nuclear plants of this configuration should be reinvestigated as part of the revised and much delayed Energy review and policy review of EN6 Nuclear. I believe all direct extraction for cooling purposes should be stopped as a matter of new build policy, currently it also then allows use of the sea to dispose of radiation and heavy metals via the return pipes. Even if this is to permitted levels it may not be best available technique. We should not be using our marine environment so callously.
