

Doc Ref 16 – Technical Standards - Land spreading for soil conditioning

The land restoration activity is in line with the recommendations and developed from the industry standard text: “Landscaping and Revegetation of China Clay Waste” - issued by the Department of the Environment (1993).

All sections are relevant.

As agreed with local Environment Agency Officers during Pre-application consultation, the operating conditions of the appropriate and equivalent Standard Rules will be implemented where suitable. In the instance of the land restoration activity (soil conditioning) at Scarcewater Tip, the Standard Rules are SR 2010: No 04 and SR2010 No 5.

- Any liquid waste shall be stored within a secure container, tank or lagoon with appropriate freeboard.
- Created topsoil and subsoils to conform to BS3882:2015 and BS8601:2013, respectively
