

Non-Technical Summary – G A Carlyon Haulage & Plant Hire

Overview

G A Carlyon are a small independent family run Company based in Mount Hawk. The business has been trading for over 70 years. The Company owns the land in which it is seeking an Environmental Permit and prior to its purchase rented the land for open storage of plant, equipment and some recycled hardcore.

The site is situated in a secluded rural area with a minimum amount of nearby residential properties. Access to the site is good with main feed road recently being upgraded by the local authority.

G A Carlyon are well known in the local market for plant hire, haulage and contracting and have established regular customer base supplying these services to both professional contractors (General builders, specialist contractors, and the domestic market.

The land has an established use by G A Carlyon for storage of plant, equipment and storage of building materials. To date the site has been used in a low-key operation, but G A Carlyon are aware to operate the site in a compliant manor they need to obtain an Environmental Permit for this type of low-risk operation.

It is intended for inert wastes of soils and hardcore will be brought into site by the companies own fleet of lorries with only a few third parties using the facility. The site will not handle high volumes of waste, with primarily two waste streams of suitable soils and hardcore being imported to produce a 6f5 subbase in accordance with current WRAP guidance and a general-purpose recycled soil. Stone residue from the soil screening process will be added to the hardcore feed stocks prior to crushing therefore minimising residues from the process.

The operation will have a bespoke Factory Control Plan in accordance with current WRAP requirements to meet End of Waste for subbase.
