
5. Supporting Documentation

APPENDIX 1

VYNOVA RUNCORN SHEQ POLICY

Our Business

Vynova is a leading European manufacturer of chlor-alkali products and PVC resins, with a network of production sites in five countries and more than 1,200 employees.

Founded in 2015 as the chlor-vinyls platform of the International Chemical Investors Group (ICIG), we have established ourselves as a major supplier with an extensive chemicals portfolio and multiple logistics solutions to serve our customers.

At VYNOVA Runcorn, we produce ethylene dichloride (EDC), using ethylene (supplied directly by pipeline) and chlorine to produce EDC. That EDC is shipped to the Vynova site in Wilhelmshaven (Germany) and to customers worldwide.

Situated on the banks of the River Mersey, the Runcorn site is connected by waterways to the Irish Sea. It is also very close to the UK Motorways M56 and M6, providing it with excellent access to logistic facilities and export markets.

As a responsible manufacturer, Vynova Runcorn Limited is certified to the ISO 9001 (Quality) and the ISO 14001(Environmental) management standards.

Our SHEQ Policy

Vynova aims to meet and, where possible, exceed our industries' strict Safety, Health, Environment and Quality (SHEQ) standards and regulations.
