I would like to support the facilities that the Green-waste wash plant can deliver. As part of our WCC reactive service we regularly request Green-waste sweepers to attend to incidents that require carriageway sweeping. As you would be aware the contents of these sweepers need to be processed and as such this is the function of the wash plant that Mr Jordan is looking to install.

We also use jetting units to empty our surface water drainage assets , the contents of these units also require processing, especially during flood events.

I have seen the by products that can be separated out by these types of wash plants and they can be fully utilised for construction materials such as sharp sand and pea gravel as well as filter / drainage media. So there is a lot of recycling potential possible at wash plants like the one Mr Jordan is planning on installing.
