I have been reviewing your application.

An additional payment is required to proceed. Adding washing means the activity type will change from physical treatment of non-hazardous waste to physical and chemical treatment of waste. The fee to change an activity type is the substantial variation charge for the replacement activity. See section 3.6.3 of our [charging guidance](#). The substantial variation charge for physical and chemical treatment of waste (charging reference 1.16.14) is £7,137. Therefore, an additional fee of £4,758 is required.
