 In accordance with the guidance, <u>Environmental permitting: air dispersion modelling reports -</u> <u>GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)</u>, please submit the data input files for the ammonia modelling.
 Question 2a of application form Part B3.5 quotes an incorrect pre-application reference for this site. The correct reference is EPR/KP3721SL/P001. Please amend the form.
 In question 8i of application form Part B3.5, you have stated that no manure is stored on the facility. The ammonia screening request form stated a maximum of 30 tonnes/day of manure is stored on site. This is also confirmed in the technical standards document 'A small amount of litter is stored at the installation (Maximum 30t in a covered trailer)'. The ammonia modelling report states 'no manure is stored on site and all manure is exported'. Please clarify which is correct and amend the application form and any relevant documents to reflect this. 4. Please add a north arrow and scale to the site boundary plan.

5. Please ensure the BAT document is specific to the Staxton Hens site as it refers to Wawne Hill Farm.

6. Please submit a revised accident risk assessment which covers measures in place for firewater containment.

7. Please confirm whether additional gable end fans are in place for summer cooling, as stated in the ammonia screening request form, and update the plan and other relevant documents as required.

a Please confirm what any effluent resulting from the egg packing area is likely to consist of, maximum volumes of the effluent per day and how it is disposed of.
