Further to my earlier email, I have finished reviewing your application and require the following information before your application can be duly made:

1. Submit a revised site drainage plan, addressing the following points:
  - Indicate the direction of dirty water flow from the pig houses and manure pad to the dirty water tanks.
  - Add point D1, to indicate the point of discharge to the ditch from pig houses 1 to 4.
  - Add ventilation on the pig houses.
  - Add the location of the carcass store.
  - Add an appropriate legend, if needed.
2. Update the non-technical summary (NTS) as follows:
  - Reference the attenuation pond shown on the site drainage plan, prior to discharge to ditch at emission point D2.
  - Ensure the weight range of the pigs is consistent with the SCR. The SCR currently states 'Pigs will arrive at circa 20-30kg and leave at circa 110kg' but the NTS states 'pigs from 15kg to finish (approx. 110kg)'.
3. Update the site condition report (SCR) as follows:
  - Part of the site falls within flood zone 2 and part of the site falls within a source protection zone. Reference this in Section 2.0 of the SCR.
  - Ensure the weight range of the pigs is consistent with the NTS. The SCR currently states 'Pigs will arrive at circa 20-30kg and leave at circa 110kg' but the NTS states 'pigs from 15kg to finish (approx. 110kg)'.
  - Reference the attenuation pond shown on the site drainage plan, prior to discharge to ditch at emission point D2.
4. Declaration – one of the declarations is in the name of John Stephen Robert Tindall. Can you confirm whether this is Robert Tindall as included on the 'list of partners' document.

Please reply directly to this email with your information and copy me in.

You must send us the information and or payment by **25/02/25**. Please note I will be on leave for a week from 14/02/25. If you are able to get this information back to me before then I can confirm whether we have everything we need to duly make the application before I finish.

If we do not receive this by this deadline we will return your application.

If we receive what is missing by the deadline, we will continue to check your application. We'll check to see if there's enough information for the application to be 'duly made'. Duly made means that we have all the information we need to begin determination. Determination is where we assess your application and decide if we can allow what you've asked for.

We'll let you know by email whether your application can be duly made. If it can't be duly made, we'll return your application to you.

If we do have to return your application we'll send you a partial refund of your application payment. We'll retain 20% of the correct application charge to cover our costs in reviewing your application. This maximum amount we'll retain is capped at £1,500.
