British Sugar historically operated under an old Waste Management Licence (WML) which permitted the operation of soil and sludge lagoons as part of the operation of the now closed sugar beet processing factory. The site closed for the receipt of waste in 2001 and in 2015 the WML was modernised into an Environmental Permit for the site in the aftercare phase of operations, to allow for the remediation and reclamation of the site using various recovered wastes originating from the site. This variation is to permit the remediation of the site to create a platform for future residential development on the site via a Deposit for Recovery process. In addition this variation also covers the expansion of the site boundary to include a larger proportion of the wider site area owned by British Sugar which was formerly used for beet sugar processing and the use of materials from within the existing permit boundary within the new expanded site boundary.
