## PLANT MAINTENANCE ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROL SYSTEMS

A Planned Preventative Maintenance schedule covering all plant involved in pollution prevention and control must be maintained to ensure it remains efficient and effective.

The schedule is as follows:-
