



WORK INSTRUCTION WI EMS 17 V1

VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

Diesel and oil spillages are a potential environmental pollutant. Care should be taken to minimise this risk and as such the following instructions are to be observed for all vehicle hydraulic, engine and transmission maintenance carried on site.

- Vehicles must never be parked over drains.
- Vehicles must not be parked near drains whilst maintenance work is carried out.
- Drip trays must be used under the vehicles to catch all spillages. The supplier must provide trays.
- Suppliers of maintenance services must be trained in the use of spill kits and pollution prevention measures.
- Suppliers' employees must be provided with spill kits or familiar with the location and use of site kits.
- Disposal of waste fluid must be as Hazardous Waste either into the appropriate vessels on site or removed for disposal by the supplier.
- Suppliers' employees must be familiar with the site Emergency Spill Procedure.
- In the event of a spillage, then implement –

Emergency Spill Procedure WI EMS 7

- Report any pollution incidences to the Mill Manager or his deputy.
