

Arundel Tidal Walls Scheme - Phase 2

Newsletter 13 – September 2024

The work on Arundel Tidal Walls Scheme (Phase 2) is nearing completion. This work is essential and will provide better protection to the town from flooding and erosion.

We update our website weekly with useful information and progress. There is also a frequently asked questions document.

What has happened so far

Construction started on 31 July 2023 and by 25 November 2023 the sheet piling phase was successfully completed with all piles in place at Tarrant Wharf and the Old Warehouse. In March 2024, the project designers reviewed the previous designs and proposed using foam concrete as a more efficient, lower-density alternative behind the sheet pile wall.

All barges have now been removed from the river, with the final bits of work to be completed from the land. The capping beam and concrete pouring are now finished, leaving just the final works remaining.

The River Road compound was demobilised during August, which included the removal of track matting, the crane, and all other equipment from the car park. Remedial works were completed where necessary to ensure the area was returned to its original condition. The site has been thoroughly cleared, and any damage has been repaired. The River Road car park will soon be handed back to Arun District Council.

What will be happening next?

Work will now progress to finalise the finishing details along the new sheet pile wall, including completing the balustrades, ladders, paving and walls.

Following this, Mill Road compound will be fully demobilised in October 2024. Once all equipment has been removed, the car park will be fully open for use by visitors.

How will the work impact traffic and parking around Arundel?
