

# Arundel Tidal Walls Scheme

Construction on the Arundel Tidal Walls Scheme (Phase 1 and 2) began in October 2019 and is nearing completion. As our work comes to an end, we want to take this opportunity to say goodbye and thank you.

The scheme has delivered a new 93-meter sheet pile wall along the River Arun, alongside other improvements to walls and embankments, providing vital flood protection to 176 homes and numerous businesses in River Road, Tarrant Wharf, and the surrounding area on both banks of the river. This has completed a challenging but rewarding project that we are proud to have undertaken.

This will be our final newsletter. We are deeply grateful for your patience during construction and the support you've shown throughout the project.

The Arundel Tidal Walls Scheme has completed all planned capital investment in Arundel.

Any future works and ongoing maintenance of the river walls in the town will be the responsibility of the riparian owners. Further information on riparian rights and responsibilities can be found on the Arun District Council, West Sussex County Council and Environment Agency pages on gov.uk.

We will be continuing with our usual watercourse maintenance activities in the area.

For any future flood risk management issues, we will be working with West Sussex County Council, Arun District Council and Arundel Town Council through the Arun Flood Forum.
