

**Guide to the permit
Endless Energy, Aire Valley Road, Keighley
Application EPR/ZP3537AT**

Front cover and introductory note – explains who the permit is issued to and what activity the permit covers.

Conditions:

Condition 1: Management conditions including:

- general management of the site;
- using energy and raw materials efficiently; and
- avoiding, recovery and disposal of wastes produced at the site.

Condition 2: Operations including :

- what activities can be carried out on the site, where they can be carried out and how; and
- conditions that must be completed before operation and after commissioning.

Condition 3: Emissions regarding emission limits to air, fugitive emissions and emissions of odour and noise.

Condition 4: Information including the records that must be kept and the reports and notifications that must be made to the Environment Agency.

Schedules (provide specific details for the sites and link to some of the conditions described above)

Schedule 1: Gives details of the activities that are covered by the permit and also the details in information submitted by the Operator which they use to operate the facility. It also gives details of the conditions which must be met before operating the facility and following commissioning.

Schedule 2: give specific information on the raw materials that can be used and the waste that can be accepted by the site.

Schedule 3: describes the emission limits and monitoring requirements for the facility.

Schedule 4: describes what the Operator has to report and when.

Schedule 5: provides the form which the Operator needs to use to tell us when they need to notify us of something.



Schedule 6: provides a definition of some of the terms used in the permit.

Schedule 7: give the boundary of the site within which the permitted activities can take place.
