Keighley and Stockbridge Flood Alleviation Scheme (FAS)

The Environment Agency is working with our professional partners to look at potential options to better manage flood risk in Keighley and Stockbridge.

As part of informing our work, we need to carry out a number of in-depth surveys at various locations in the area. This includes ground investigations and site investigations.

These investigations, which will be undertaken by Arup and BAM Nuttall on behalf of the Environment Agency, will commence in May and will last for approximately 8 weeks.

Most of this work will not cause any disruption, but you may see staff from Arup and BAM Nuttall in and around the area during this time. However, some of the investigations will involve more obvious works and you will see plant and equipment cordoned off to allow BAM Nuttall to work safely and protect the public. Where appropriate, pavement diversions may be in place and alternative routes sign posted.

Any property and/or asset owners who will be affected directly by our work will be contacted by a member of the project team to discuss the proposals or will receive a formal Notice of Entry for information.
