Site investigations

You may have noticed a lot of activity around Tadcaster over the last few weeks; people in Hi Vis carrying equipment, and coloured numbers and arrows sprayed on the ground.



Our construction partners are carrying out vital surveys which will further inform the detailed design of the Tadcaster Flood Alleviation Scheme.

These surveys, which are non-intrusive, include 3D laser scans of the bridge elevations and arches, ground penetrating radar, CCTV surveys of pipes and drainage, sonde transmitters and topographic surveys.

There are a number of areas where these surveys are being deployed, running from the viaduct, past Crane Cottages, along to the Ings, on both sides of the river.

These surveys should not cause any inconvenience, and are due to be completed around the 9th September.
