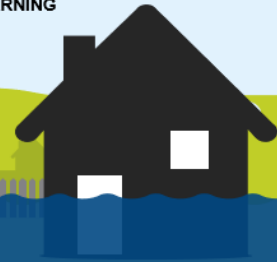

PREPARE FLOOD ALERT

- ✓ Prepare a bag that includes medicines and insurance documents
- ✓ Visit check-for-flooding.service.gov.uk

ACT FLOOD WARNING

- ✓ Turn off gas, water and electricity
- ✓ Move things upstairs or to safety
- ✓ Move family, pets and car to safety

SURVIVE SEVERE FLOOD WARNING

- ✓ Call 999 if in immediate danger
- ✓ Follow advice from emergency services
- ✓ Keep yourself and your family safe

Receive flood warnings by phone, email or text
