Clementhorpe Flood Alleviation Scheme

Project update

This document provides an update on the Clementhorpe Flood Alleviation Scheme. It is published electronically at regular intervals to anyone on the Clementhorpe mailing list. It will also be made available on our webpages.

Announcement of start of construction

We are happy to announce that we have received approval from City of York Council (CYC) to begin construction of the Clementhorpe Flood Alleviation Scheme. We have spent the last four months working hard with CYC to resolve issues raised relating to the pre-commencement planning conditions. These condition have now been successfully discharged. Construction will begin on Monday, 1 March 2021 and is expected to take 18 months to complete.

Key aspects of the scheme

Our construction team will initially focus on building the construction compound, which will be located at the football pitch at the south end of Rowntree Park. We expect this will take 4 weeks to complete.

During construction, parking on all of the north side of Butcher Terrace and some of the south side of Butcher Terrace will be suspended, with alternative parking provided to residents within the construction compound, once it is built. Access to private driveways on Butcher Terrace will not be affected.

As part of the construction programme, Terry Avenue will be closed between its junction with Skeldergate and Roomzzz Hotel, for approximately 12 months. The date when the closure will come into effect will be around 1 April 2021, but we will confirm this closer to the time. Diversion routes for cyclists and pedestrians have been agreed with CYC and a copy of our Construction Traffic Management Plan will be shared with this newsletter, containing relevant information.
