




On 21 March we submitted our planning application for the Clementhorpe Flood Alleviation scheme, ref 19/00570/FUL. The scheme will better protect 135 properties from the risk of flooding between Skeldergate Bridge and Rowntree Park.

A number of objections have been received. In response, we are currently providing further information to City of York Council. On 16 May, a call in request was made for the application to be determined at planning committee. At this stage a date for committee has not been confirmed. We continue to listen to the community to understand their concerns. We will attend a public meeting, chaired by local Councillors, on 15 July at Southlands Methodist Church to update the community.










Figure 2: Areas of concern related to access proposal*



We need to close a section of Terry Avenue for up to 18 months. Access is proposed via Butcher Terrace along Terry Street, reinstating the byway to a public highway. This has raised significant concerns, particularly from cyclists and pedestrians.




Figure 3: Areas of concern related to proposed diversion*



Our cyclists diversion is proposed along New Walk on the opposite bank. To re join the right bank of the river at Skeldergate, we have proposed crossing St George's Field car park and coach park and travelling over Skeldergate Bridge. This has raised safety concerns.
